



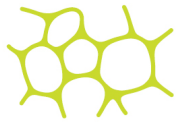

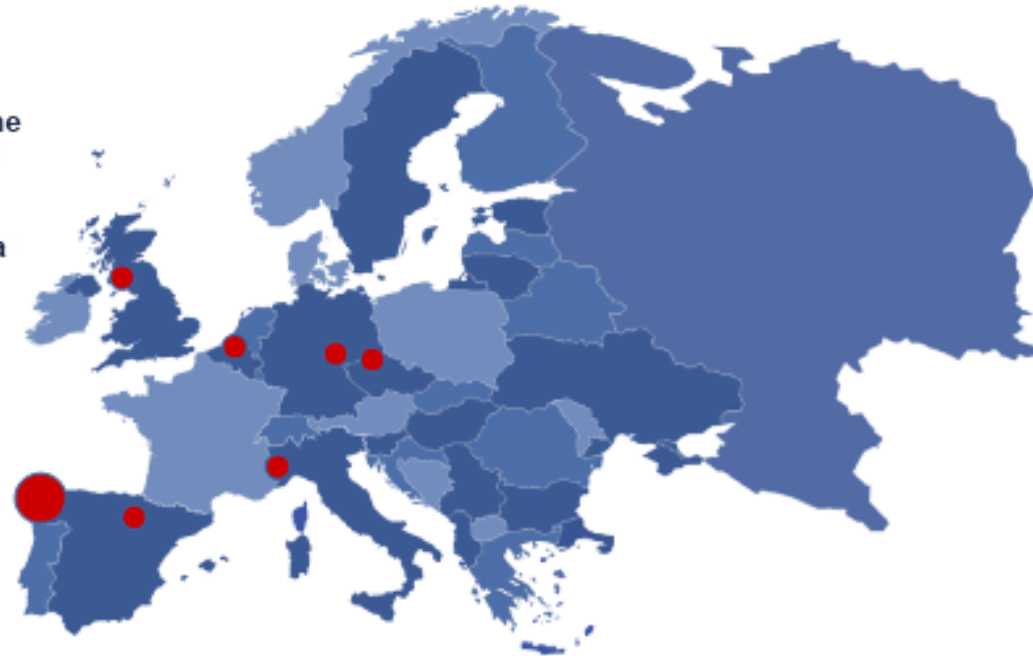

Challenges addressed

- ❖ European population is ageing rapidly. The number of people aged 65 and over is projected to increase from 14% in 2010 to 25% in 2050.
- ❖ Advances in science and technology contribute to prolong people lifespan, but unfortunately that does not mean they will be healthier.
- ❖ In its headline strategic document “EU2020 Strategy”, the EC has identified active and healthy ageing as a major societal challenge common to all European Countries.

PHASE 1

- **Elaboration of Action Plans** (one per region or interregional): actions that will be put in place to improve Policy Instruments, in relation to the project Thematic Areas.
